#### Welcome to Bushloe Surgery

At the end of October we said goodbye to Dr Tracy Tobin who had been with the practice for 27 years. We would like to thank her for all her years of service and wish her a long and happy retirement. Dr Tobin will be missed by staff and patients alike.

We continue to be busy as a teaching practice and at the time of writing are supporting 3rd and 5th year medical students as well as a nursing student. 6 GP registrars continue their placements with us—Bushloe is a busy place to be!

#### Vaccine clinics

Our main covid and flu clinics have now taken place and we have vaccinated 2162 patients eligible for Covid and 2364 patients eligible for the flu vaccine.

If you were between 75—79 on September 1st 2024 or are 28 weeks or more pregnant, you are eligible for the RSV (respiratory syncytial vaccine) Please ask at reception to book your appointment.

You can also book pneumonia and shingles if you are eligible.

#### Key reminders/FAQs

Coughs & Colds season—your GP surgery is not always the best place for advice. Pharmacies can provide over the counter medication and antibiotics for certain conditions.

Please consider using your pharmacy first before contacting us.

Our reception team may also offer you a pharmacy referral for symptoms such as urinary tract infections, sore throats, impetigo etc. They have a clearly defined list and will only use this pathway if the patient fits certain criteria.

#### In November we .....

- Handled 11209 calls to our main telephone number
- Had 9631 appointments booked
- Issued approximately 6488 prescriptions
- 708 requests were made using Contact the Practice
- Had a total of 13157 patients registered with us. In November 2023 we had 12569 patients—that's 558 more now registered!)
- Unfortunately, 134 appointments were not attended.

This service has a 5 working day turnaround so must only be used for non-urgent appointments.

Use this service if you need to request a <u>repeat</u> fit note to be absent from work.
