Vaccine clinics

If you were between 75—79 on September 1st 2024 or are 28 weeks or more pregnant, you are eligible for the RSV (respiratory syncytial vaccine) Please ask at reception to book your appointment.

You can also book pneumonia and shingles if you are eligible.

The Spring COVID campaign has been announced and more details will follow in March. <u>Only</u> those 75 and older, care home residents or those who are severely immunocompromised will be invited.



How to order your prescription

Please order your medications a week in advance of them running out.

Prescriptions take 3 working days to complete.

Our team are trained to ask relevant questions so they can book you with the most appropriate clinician.

NHS Health Checks

Patients between 40 & 74 will be invited for an NHS healthcheck every 5 years. You can expect to have bloods taken, a discussion about health conditions in your family history, exercise, smear tests, checking breasts and bowel cancer screening.

The information given enables the health care assistants to compete a template to see what health risks you may have so we can help manage them.


